Introduction

In accordance with the 1986 national education policy, one Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya is to be established in each district of the country. The primary objective is to make it possible for children, most of who come from rural areas, to receive a high-quality education. These schools have, for the most part, been able to achieve academic excellence, instill cultural values, teach three languages, encourage an adventurous spirit, promote national integration, and ultimately work toward the children's holistic development.

Since its modest beginnings in 1986, when there were just two Vidyalaya's, the nationwide network of Vidyalaya's now spans 650 districts. The quality of the education provided in these Vidyalaya's is reflected in the academic performance of the Vidyalaya's X class students on the Board Examination. In order to guarantee that the students who graduate from the Vidyalaya will be able to contribute to society, these schools have been outfitted with cutting-edge educational technology. In recent years, the post-school profiles of students indicate that they are well-positioned in society.

Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya was established by the Indian government in accordance with the National Policy of Education (1986). The JNVs are present in 28 states and 8 Union Territories at the moment. These coeducational residential schools are entirely funded and run by the Indian government through an independent organization called Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti. The Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya Selection Test is used to select students for admission to JNVs in class VI. Students of JNVs take the Central Board of Secondary Education's X class examinations. The medium of instruction is the mother tongue or regional language up to class VIII, followed by English for Math and Science and Hindi for Social Science. While tuition, housing, uniforms, and textbooks are provided for free by the school, a small fee of Rs. 600, children in classes IX to XII will need to be paid per month. However, fees are not due for children of SC/ST, girls, physically disabled, or families living below the poverty line. For the vacant seats in class IX, the NVS Headquarters in New Delhi has provided for lateral entry. The Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya Vankal, Dist. Surat, is a special instructive Organization. Its significance lies in the attempt to provide talented rural students from Surat District with a high-quality education and in selecting them as the target group. In the year 2019, this JNV was established at Maldha village at temporary site.

The purpose of this publication is to provide an inside view of various aspects of the Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya, Vankal, Dist. Surat.




1. The Sun Symbolizes Navodaya.

7. Our Motto: Intelligence is Divine





Organization of Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti



Implementation of NEP – 2020

National Education Policy lays particular emphasis on the development of the creative potential of each individual. It is based on the principle that education must develop not only cognitive capacities -both the 'foundational capacities' of literacy and numeracy and 'higher-order' cognitive capacities, such as critical thinking and problem solving – but also social, ethical, and emotional capacities and dispositions.  - Promoting multilingualism and the power of language in teaching and learning;
 - Life skills such as communication, cooperation, teamwork, and resilience;
 - Focus on regular formative assessment for learning rather than the summative assessment that encourages today's 'coaching culture'

Selection Process

Selection of students is one of the core processes in JNVs. Therefore, it has been very transparent and is totally handled by the CBSE. The entrance exam for students is known as Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya Selection Test tagged with the year of selection like JNVST – 2025 etc.

The students learning in 5th class in the district are eligible to appear the JNVST. The registration site is kept opened for 1 to 2 months for registration. At the end, more than 6000+ students normally get registered with the site.

The exam is scheduled by the CBSE. It is conducted strictly under the keen observation of the District Education Officer at block level for candidates' convenience. T

he result is declared after 1 to 1½ months of conduct of exam. 80 students get admission in JNV for their bright future. These students stay in school for 7 years for their holistic development.

Note: At-least 10% of the questions on the pattern of competitive exams questions pertaining to the subjects should be the part of the question paper in Internal Assessment (20 Marks) (Class IX & X)

(i) Pen Paper Test (05 Marks):

The school should conduct periodic written tests in the entire academic year and the average of the best two for class X and best in each term for class IX will be taken. The schools have the autonomy to make its own schedule. However, for the purpose of gradient learning, three tests may be held as one being the mid-term test and other the two being pre mid-term and post mid-term with portion of syllabus cumulatively covered. The gradually increasing portion of contents would prepare students acquire confidence for appearing in the Board examination with 100% syllabus. For class X the school will take the average of the best two tests for final marks submission.

(ii) Multiple Assessment (05 Marks):

Strategies to be used includes; quizzes, oral test, concept map, exit cards, visual expression, self and peer assessment, collaborative projects, experiments. Classroom demonstration etc.

(iii) Portfolio (05 marks):

It includes Class work plus peer assessment, self-assessment, achievements of student in the subject, reflections, narrations, journals, etc.

(iv) Subject Enrichment Activities (05 Marks):

These are subject specific application activities aimed at enrichment of the understanding and skill development. These activities are to be recorded internally by respective subject teachers.

For Languages: Activities conducted for subject enrichment in languages should aim at equipping the learner to develop effective speaking and listening skills.

For Mathematics: The listed laboratory activities and projects as given in the prescribed publication of CBSE/NCERT may be followed.

For Science: The listed practical works / activities may be carried out as prescribed by the CBSE in the curriculum. For Social Science: Project work may be undertaken as prescribed by the CBSE in the curriculum.

Co-Scholastic Activities:

Assessment of Art education and health & Physical Education may be continuously done by collecting information, reflecting on and using that information to review children's progress and to plan future learning experiences. The documented data after interpretation should be reflected in the report card of the children in the form of grades. In the scheme of assessment, these activities will be graded on a 5-point grading scale (A to E) for classes IX-X and will have no descriptive indicators. The students shall be assessed on two areas i.e. Art Education, Health and Physical Education. Work Experience is subsumed in the Physical and Health Education. No up scaling of grades will be done. While the students are engaged in the core areas like: Health and Physical Education and Art Education, the process is as important as the product. Hence the assessment in these areas should take account of both aspects. The basis of assessment has been suggested below:


